



Declaration of Conformity to California Proposition 65

This document is to confirm that some items produced and sold by MARX Software Security GmbH and MARX CryptoTech LP contain substances which are listed on California's Safe Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986.

This Act, commonly known as Proposition 65, requires businesses to notify Californians about significant chemicals that cause cancer or birth defects or other reproductive harm. The law requires that no person doing business, knowingly and intentionally expose an individual to a chemical known to the state of California to cause cancer, birth defects, or reproductive toxicity without first giving a clear and reasonable warning.
